POLICY FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE

College Committee for Education Quality Office for Quality of Education

- defining criteria used to assess the effects of the didactic process;
- monitoring the evaluation of learning outcomes on the labour market;
- developing a system solution in the field of improving quality standards;
- defining criteria and tools for assessing the functioning of Internal Quality Assurance System at the University;
- supervision over implementation and further improvement of Internal Quality Assurance System.

- development of draft normative acts of the University bodies in the field of providing and improving the quality of education;
- development of documentation necessary to monitor and analyse the quality of education;
- monitoring and analysis of the course of education;
- monitoring and analysis of learning outcomes.

Faculty Council Dean Faculty Team for Quality of Education

- analysis of reports of the Office for Quality of Education,
 Dean's Office and results of assessment visits;
- analysis of opinions and proposals of external and internal stakeholders, including students' applications and complaints;






